By the 10 April	Parents/ caregivers	<p>Parents need to complete and submit their digital/paper EOI form.</p> <p>Please note:</p> <p><u>Local students</u> will be able to attend Strathfield Girls High School, provided documentation supports the school's enrolment policy. Local non-government primary school students need to collect and return their EOI forms directly to Strathfield Girls High School.</p> <p><u>Non- local students</u> will need to submit the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Submit a portfolio of your daughter's interests, abilities, and achievements both in and out of school to SGHS front office. • List SGHS as your Choice 1. Due to the high demand for our school, Choices 2 and 3 will not be considered. • Seek an endorsement letter from the primary school principal or class teacher. <p><u>Gifted and Talented Stream</u></p> <p>On Orientation Day, there will be an opportunity for all new enrolments to complete the Acer Test. The test report will allow the school to best support your daughter in her learning and assist us with student placement in the Gifted and Talented stream.</p>
On 10 May	Primary Schools	<p>Last day for primary schools to complete processing digital EOI's and entering any paper EOI information into Online Enrolment System.</p>

<p>From 13 May</p>	<p>Secondary Schools</p>	<p><u>Round 1 Begins for Non-Local Applicants</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A placement panel will convene to consider non-local enrolment applications (Deputy Principal, Head Teacher Wellbeing, Year Advisor, Parent Representative and Enrolment Officer). • Choice 1 application forms and portfolios will be reviewed. • Primary schools and parents/caregivers will be advised of outcome of Choice 1 non-local applications by <u>27 May 2024.</u> • If necessary, a waiting list will be compiled.
<p>During October/ November</p>	<p>Principal, Parents & Students</p>	<p>SGHS invite all successful applicants and their parents/caregivers to an interview with the principal. The aim of this interview is to gather information about students such as learning outcomes, leadership skills, extra-curricular and sporting interests as well as family/welfare concerns. Valuable information is also given to students about our school and the Year 7 camp. These interviews enable us to support your daughter through her transition to high school.</p>
