8 March	Parents, students	Attend Information Evening at Strathfield Girls High School. The Information Evening, including school tour, at the School is on 5 March 2018 commencing at 6.00pm and concluding at 8.00pm.
By Early-March	Primary School	All primary schools have issued to parents/caregivers the <i>Moving into Year 7 in a government primary school</i> (EOI) booklet for placement in secondary school.
By 16 March	Parents/ caregivers	<p>Parents need to return the form located in the <i>Expression of Interest for Placement in Year 7 at a NSW Government Secondary School in 2019</i> to their primary school.</p> <p>Please note: Local students – will be able to attend Strathfield Girls High School, provided documentation supports the school's enrolment policy.</p> <p>For Non- local students:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Attach a resume of your daughter's interests, abilities and achievements both in and out of school. • Ask your primary school principal to endorse your daughter's application. • List SGHS as your Choice 1 as due to the high demand for the school. Choices 2 & 3 will not be considered. • Private school students need to collect (also on our website) and return their EOI forms directly to Strathfield Girls High School.
By 4 April	Primary School	Final day for primary schools to copy and forward EOI forms to Choice 1 non-local schools. Private school students need to collect and return their EOI forms by this date to Strathfield Girls High School.
By 28 May	Secondary School	<p><u>Round 1</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Convene a placement panel to consider non-local enrolment applications (Principal, Deputy Principal, Head Teacher Wellbeing , Year Adviser, Parent Representative and Enrolment Officer) • Review Choice 1 application forms • Advise primary schools and parents/caregivers of outcome of Choice 1 non-local applications • Compile a waiting list
By 7 September	Secondary Principal	All confirmation letters sent to parents/caregivers.
November	Principal, Parents and Students	SGHS invite all successful applicants and their parents/caregivers to an interview with the Principal . The aim of this interview is to gather information about students such as learning outcomes, leadership skills, extra-curricular and sporting interests as well as family/welfare concerns. Valuable information is also given to students about camp etc. These interviews enable us to support your daughter through her transition to high school.
Tuesday, 4 December	Secondary School	Orientation Day for all accepted Year 6 students and parents at 9:30am in the School Hall.
