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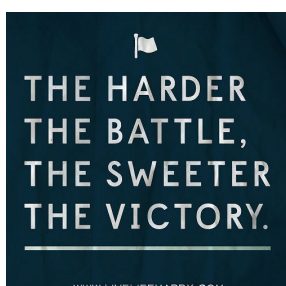
Victory for the Year 10 Debate Team

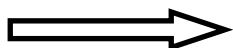
