Congratulations Cadets!!

Alekhya Immadi and Lasya Kantimaneni, both of Year 10, were placed first in the cadet teams State First Aid Camps organised by St John's Ambulance. Both young women have been in the cadetship program for almost 4 years and will be going on the represent New South Wales in the National Competition in January 2020.

Cadet divisions meet regularly—usually once per week during school terms. Meetings can include things like learning first aid, fun games and activities, and working on Proficiency Courses. Once a proficiency course is achieved, cadets are awarded a certificate and a badge to place on their uniform.

When the first badge is achieved, cadets will be on their way to meeting the requirements of The Grand Prior's Award (which requires a minimum of 12 badges).

Completing it is an outstanding achievement. There are two proficiencies which are compulsory for earning The Grand Prior's Award; Health Care and Caring and the Knowledge of the Order badges.
