Staff and students also attended the Strathfield Council Women's Day celebration at the council offices.

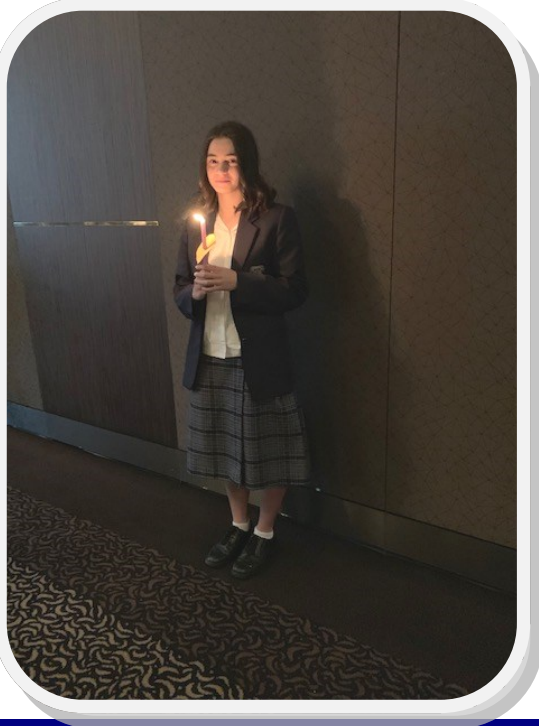
